Re: REQUEST FOR COLLABORATION ON "APPLICATION OF DEVELOPED OCCUPATIONAL STANDARDS AND PROGRAM DELIVERY STANDARDS - TANZANIA-CHINA JOINT TALENT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT" TO SUPPORT TVET DEVELOPMENT IN TANZANIA

Please refer to the above captioned subject.

2. The Council is glad to know that the Development of Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards (2nd Batch) Project has reached its final stages until August, 2023. Thanks to the efforts and dedication of Chinese technical and vocational institutes and TVET experts from China and Tanzania. Most of the required documents have been received and approved by the National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET). The Council will continue to process these documents including publication and offer them for use and application by and for the benefit of our institutes in Tanzania. The Council is also happy to know that the Development of Curriculum Standards and National TVET Teaching and Training Resource Database is progressing smoothly.

- 3. With both the Occupational Standards and the corresponding Program Delivery Standards being ready, and National TVET Teaching and Training Resource Database being under development, the Council is planning to further promote the dissemination and implementation of existing Occupational Standards and the corresponding Program Delivery Standards. Thus, the Council is requesting your support and has granted you authorization in mobilizing the necessary resources from China to jointly implement the "Application of Developed Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards - Tanzania-China Joint Talent Development Project". According to Hon. Omari Juma Kipanga, Deputy Minister of Education, Science and Technology in Tanzania, during this Project, the Council will select, batch by batch, over 500 Tanzanian TVET institutions out of the 1,329 registered nationwide, under the Council's supervision, to carry out One-on-One Collaborations with a large number of Chinese TVET institutions selected and mobilized by your offices-China-Africa Vocational Education Alliance, China-Africa (Chongqing) Vocational Education Alliance, CIIC International Education Technology (Beijing) Co., Ltd, and Sunmaker Training Institute. The purpose of the Project is to work within the framework of the Tanzanian National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards developed by Chinese TVET institutions, guiding Tanzanian TVET institutions to gain deeper understanding of the development approach and application scenarios. The ultimate goal is to promote the implementation and dissemination of National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards in TVET institutions in Tanzania, utilizing normative requirements for the working ability level of employees to guide TVET teaching activities.
- 4. The Project encompasses, but is not limited to, the following aspects:
  - i) Institutional-Level Curriculum Adjustment and Development and Teaching Resource Development including Long Courses and Short Courses: Chinese TVET institutions should support Tanzanian TVET institutions in curriculum review and development, teaching material compilation, and resource development based on the existing National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standard framework under specific context of the Tanzanian TVET Institutions. The developed courses and resources will serve as the foundation for TVET teaching in a certain program for the Tanzanian TVET institution and will also be included in the National TVET Teaching & Training Resource Database.
  - ii) Capacity Building: Tanzanian TVET teachers should receive capacity building from Chinese TVET institutions based on the Tanzanian National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards to ensure the effective implementation of these standards in teaching activities. This should be implemented through both offline and online channels. Experts

from China should continuously visit Tanzania Institutions, and also some of the Tanzanian Lecturers should be sent to China to the capacity building activities. The Capacity Building should also be carried out for Partner Industries of Tanzania Institutions including enterprises from both Tanzania and China.

iii) Joint Talent Cultivation, Education and Training: Tanzanian and Chinese TVET institutions will collaborate in training students based on the Tanzanian National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards. There should be mutual recognition of credits and graduation certifications among Tanzanian and Chinese TVET institutions. Student Exchanges should be carried out for both Diploma Programs and Short Courses.

Please note that considering the mismatch in the scale of individual TVET institution in Tanzania and China, a Chinese TVET institution may undertake similar demands from multiple Tanzanian institutions in practice.

- 5. Below is the first batch of Tanzanian TVET institutions recommended by the Council for collaboration with Chinese TVET institutions (Appendix I). These schools are representative in key fields. Additionally, the Council will continue to filter and update Tanzanian institutions in a gradual manner.
- 6. Therefore, the Council hereby requests your assistance in selecting Chinese TVET institutions. Considering the existing TVET fields in the Tanzanian National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards, the areas of collaboration include but are not limited to the programs shown in Appendix II.
- 7. Please feel free to propose and add more programs in other sectors and areas to be collaborated to support TVET development in Tanzania under this period based on the available support capacity from your side.
- 8. The Council firmly believes that through the implementation of the aforementioned Project, the development level of TVET in Tanzania can be systematically improved. The mutual exchange and integration of Tanzania and China TVET will facilitate learning between the TVET institutions of both countries, jointly promoting the development of TVET levels. This will further facilitate the entry of high-quality technical talents into the labour market and promote the sound development of Tanzanian and Chinese enterprises. The Council is looking forward to cooperating with you on the Use and Application of National Occupational Standards and Program Delivery Standards, in order to enhance the development

of TVET Institutions in Tanzania and to ensure production of qualified graduates to feed the various sectors of the economy in the country.

Looking forward to your continued cooperation.
